Oranges

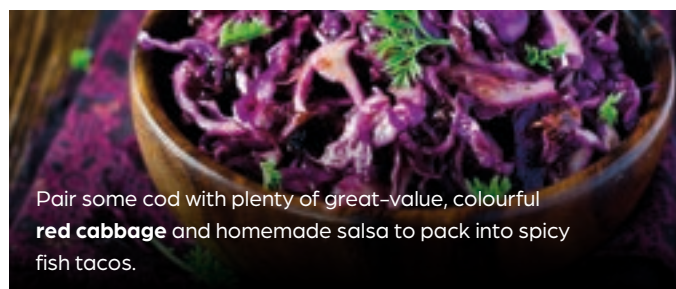
Sweet blood oranges from Italy and sour Seville oranges from Spain will bring some colourful zest to desserts, salads and more.

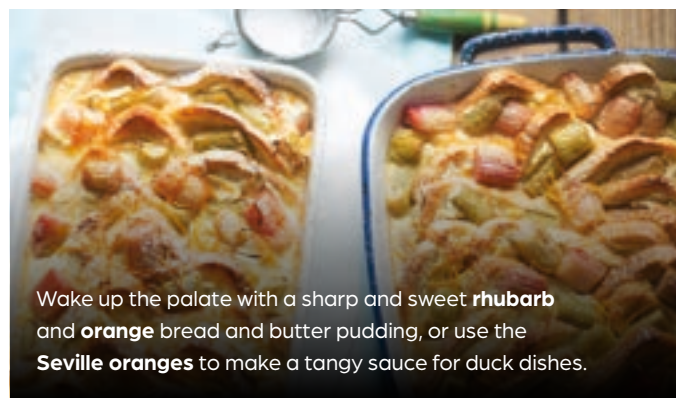
Seasonal tips and ideas from Class One Chefs



Full of goodness, **kale** is sure to be a winner for diners looking for a healthy start to the year. Make a quick kale and parmesan houmous for salads, or bake wilted kale in a pie with poached spiced **pears** and lancashire cheese for a tasty vegetarian main.
